C-c C-k	Entire file - compile and load
C-c M-k	Entire file - compile but don't load
C-c C-c	Toplevel - compile the toplevel form at point
M-p/M-n	Move to previous/next compiler note
C-c M-c	Remove all compilation notes

Evaluation

C-M-x	Evaluate top-level
C-x C-e	Evaluate last expression
C-c C-p	Evaluate last expression and pretty-print
C-c C-r	Evaluate region
C-c :	Evaluate expression from minibuffer
M-x slime-scratch	Create *slime-scratch* buffer, evaluate using C-j
